

Accessibility Features Statement

In order to make the Careers @ McMaster site more accessible, McMaster has employed templates which:

- use Verdana as the default font type, Arial as secondary;
- have help files that use text throughout (instead of screenshots) or have defined alternate text to fully describe a screenshot;
- display all system menu bars, dropdown menus and help screens in Verdana;
- provides compatibility with accessibility management software such as Zoom Text and Dragon;
- allows high contrast selection inherently within the system;
- supports high contrast selection from with the PC operating systems;
- applies ALT text to all image files thumbnails;
- supports the removal of the default image ALT text if the image is not deemed to be of contextual importance;
- supports processes to create specific alerts, able to be identified by a user with accessibility issues; and
- allows integration with Braille translation software occurs at the browser.

Increasing Text Size

To increase the text size on our Web pages, you can change the settings in your Web browser. Just follow the instructions below based on the browser you are using or see your browser's help for details.

Internet Explorer

1. Select "View" in the menu bar.
2. Select "Text Size".
3. Select "Larger" or "Largest".

Mozilla Firefox

1. Select "View" in the menu bar.
2. Select "Text Size".
3. Select "Increase".
4. To increase the text size further, continue selecting "Increase".

Netscape

1. Select "View" in the menu bar.
2. Select "Text Size".
3. From the menu, select the size with which you would like to view the Web site.
