Safe Disposal Of Empty Chemical Bottles

1. If the content is WATER SOLUBLE:
 - Collect the initial concentrated rinse and discard the chemical via the Hazardous Chemical Waste Stream (RMM# 502)
 - Rinse the empty bottle with water
 - Ensure the bottle is dry and deface/remove the label
 - Place the bottle in the hallway for custodial pick up (campus only-FHSc take to waste closet)
2. If the content is TOXIC:
 - Collect the initial concentrated rinse and discard the chemical via the Hazardous Chemical Waste Stream (RMM# 502)
 - Remove lid and place bottle in fumehood until all liquid has evaporated
 - Ensure the bottle is dry and deface/remove the label
 - Place the bottle in the hallway for custodial pick up (campus only-FHSc take to waste closet)
3. If the content is a SOLVENT:
 - Remove lid and place bottle in fumehood until all liquid has evaporated
 - Ensure the bottle is dry and deface/remove the label
 - Place the bottle in the hallway for custodial pick up (campus only-FHSc take to waste closet)

All bottles left for pick up must have the lid removed.
