This award is presented to a person or group from our McMaster community who has done an outstanding job of promoting health and safety in the workplace. This annual award is presented by Senior Management during McMaster University's celebration of North American Occupational Safety and Health (NAOSH) Week held May 1-7th, 2011. This year's theme is "What's Your Plan?"

The annual health and safety award is awarded to a person or group who has consistently shown their commitment to health and safety by taking measures to eliminate hazards and reduce accidents in the workplace. The recipient has also actively promoted safety as a priority and shown innovative methods to enhance and implement new programs within McMaster during the past year.

Previous winners of this award include Karen Sutton from Titles, Dave Stevens from Facility Services, Andy Duncan from Physics and Astronomy, Emergency First Response Team (EFRT), Security Services, and the Central Joint Health and Safety Committee.

Eligibility: This award is open to all full time or part time employees from operations, research and ancillary departments or units of McMaster University along with any McMaster student group.

The nominations must include the name, department and a detailed description of why this member(s) is deserving of this award.
